



FARM Signature Pages: In total, you should have 2 signature pages for family, 2 signatures from each non-family employee if your herd has non-family employees, and 2 signatures from your herd veterinarian.

Immediate Family Cow Care Agreement: One family member can sign for everyone considered immediate family (grandparent, parent, in-law, spouse, partner, sibling, child or grandchild of the dairy operation) This form states that the family will not mistreat animals.

Immediate Family Continuing Education Record: One family member can sign for everyone considered immediate family (grandparent, parent, in-law, spouse, partner, sibling, child or grandchild of the dairy operation) confirming individuals have been trained in the described areas. Articles should be provided in your FARM binder.

Non-Family Employee Cow Care Agreement: Each employee needs to sign this form stating they will not mistreat animals. Immediate family does NOT need to sign the form.

Non-Family Employee Continuing Education Record: Each employee needs to sign this form stating the training they have received for their daily responsibilities. The articles in this binder can be used as training material. Immediate family does NOT need to sign this form.

Veterinary Client Patient Relationship Form: This form needs to be signed annually by the farm's veterinarian stating they have a relationship with the producer/farm operation. The producer needs to sign as well.

Herd Health Plan Veterinarian Review Form: This form needs to be signed annually by the farm's veterinarian stating they have reviewed the farm's herd health plan included in their FARM program binder. The producer needs to sign as well.
